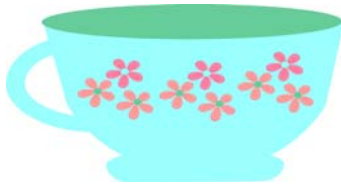

EDITING With CUPS

Editing in the primary grades is so important! We work on writing all the time and in the Common Core they are relying more on evidence based writing (1.W.1, 1.W.2) but there is still something to be said about creative writing (W.1.3). I feel that this could be used for any writing project. It helps them for their self assessment and drives their learning forward.

Of course, you would have to teach them the structure of CUPS with modeling and practice. I have color coded the letters of CUPS so they can correspond with a colored pencil or there is a black and white version if that's not how you roll!
