- 1. The Aimsir Fháistineach is the future tense, it describes events that will happen in the future.
- 2. For one syllable verbs, the following endings are used, but remember BROAD WITH BROAD, SLENDER WITH SLENDER.

Broad (for example glan)	Slender (for example fill)
Glan <mark>faidh</mark> mé, tú, sé, sí, sibh, siad	Fillfidh mé, tú, sé, sí, sibh, siad
Glanfaimid	Fillfimid

3. For two syllable verbs, we take only the root of the verb and use the following endings, but remember BROAD WITH BROAD, SLENDER WITH SLENDER.

Broad (for example ceannaigh)	Slender (bailigh)
Ceann <mark>óidh</mark> mé, tú, sé, sí, sibh, siad	Baileoidh mé, tú, sé, sí, sibh, siad
Ceannóimid	Baileoimid

4. This is the format for asking and answering questions in the Aimsir Fháistineach.

The question (?)	An/Nach + urú on consonants
Positive answer ( $$ )	No change
Negative answer (x)	Ní + séimhiú
