- 1. Séimhiú A séimhiú is a 'h' that is written after the first letter of a word for particular reasons if the word begins with b, c, d, f, g, m, p, s, or t.
- 2. Urú An urú is a specific letter which is placed before a corresponding letter for particular reasons. Here are a list of na huruithe.

- 3. Ainmfhocal An ainmfhocal is a noun...so people, places and things.
- 4. Inscne This is the gender of nouns. They can be either masculine or feminine. There are different rules for each.
- 5. Aidiacht These are adjectives...so words that give more information about nouns.
- 6. An Aidiacht Shealbhach These are possessive adjectives...they show ownership of a noun. These are the words: mo, do, a, a, ár, bhur, a.
- 7. Briathar These are verbs or action words. We must always consider the tense when using verbs.

8. An tAinm Briathartha - These are verbal nouns...such as ag imirt, ag léamh



- 9. Dobhriathar These are adverbs. They give more information about verbs.
- 10. Réamhfhocal Simplí These are prepositions which tell us the location of nouns.
- 11. Réamhfhocal Comhshuite These are compound prepositions or prepositions with more than one word...such as i rith, ar feadh, tar éis.
- 12. Forainm Pearsanta These are pronouns, used in the place of nouns.

 These are the words we use: mé, tú, sé/é, sí/í, muid/sinn, sibh, siad/iad.
- 13. Forainm Réamhfhoclach These are a combinations of a pronoun and a prepositions...or prepositional pronouns...that doesn't make much sense so this is what we mean: ar mé = orm or leis + mé = liom.
- 14. Céimeanna Comparáide na hAidiachtaí these are the words used to compare adjectives in order to create the comparative and superlative cases.
