1. The Aidiacht Shealbhach is what we call the possessive adjective.
2. These are the changes that follow the Aidiacht Shealbhach:

Aidiacht Shealbhach	Consonant	Vowel
mo (my)	+ séimhiú	m'
do (your)	+ séimhiú	d'
a (his)	+séimhiú	no change
a (her)	no change	h before the word
ár (our)	+urú	urú (n-)
bhur (your plural)	+urú	urú (n-)
a (their)	+urú	urú (n-)

3. Two points just doesn't seem like enough so here are a few examples:

Aidiacht Shealbhach	Consonant	Vowel
mo	mo chóta	m'úll
do	do mhadra	d'aintín
a	a gheansaí	a arán
a	a mála	a hamhrán
ár	ár gceapairí	ár n-iasc
bhur	bhur gcáca	bhur n-oráiste
a	a ndinnéar	a n-uisce
