- 1. The Tuiseal Ginideach Uatha is the singular genitive case...so it sees a noun as modifying another noun.
- 2. The reasons we use the T.G. Uatha are as follows:
 - Ownership (or two nouns together)...for example socrúchán scoile, deireadh na mblianta
 - Word that mean an amount or a quantity...such as: a lán, mórán, beagán
 - After verbal nouns...for example: ag ithe, ag rith, ag cur
 - Prepositions with more than one word (compound)...such as: le linn, tar éis, i rith
 - After certain prepositions (chun, cois, dála, fearacht, timpeall, trasna)
