


We learned already that there are 32 counties in Ireland. We already visited one of them the other day on our road trip.

You would see the county colours at G.A.A matches!









I'm going to show you a county colours. All you have to do is figure out which county these are the colours of. I will even show you their G.A.A jersey too for an extra help!



































Today, we're going to be making a map of Ireland that shows the county colours of each county. When we put all the pieces back together again, it will be like a jigsaw. The medium we'll be using today is called collage.

Look closely, what do you notice?


These pieces of art are made by an artist from California called Jay Kelly.

Jay uses a technique called collage to make his art pieces. How do you think he makes these pieces?




To make his pictures, Jay first looks for examples of the colour he needs in magazines, newspapers and anywhere else.

He then chops them up small and sticks them where they need to be 'painted'.



Collage can be simple, with just a few shades and tones.








First, you need to figure out which county you have been given by finding it on the map of Ireland on your desk.
