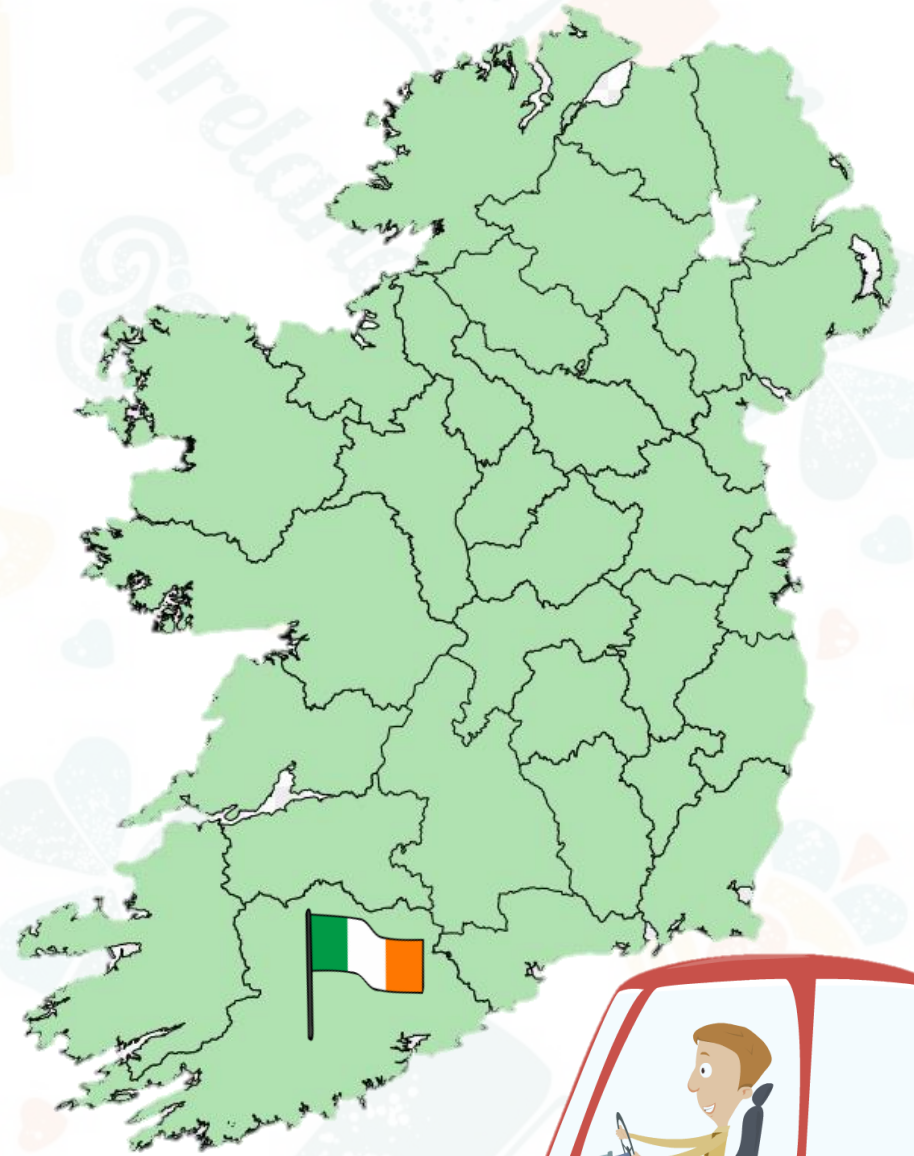

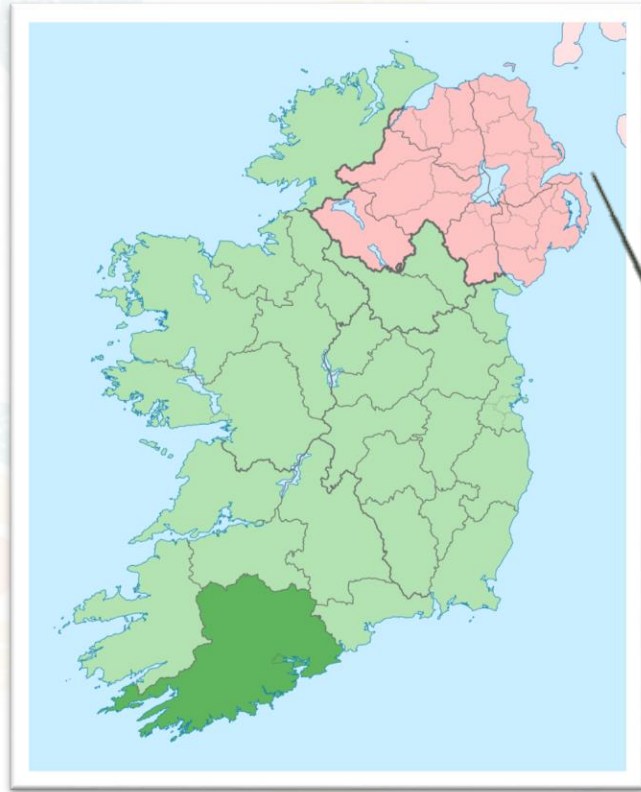

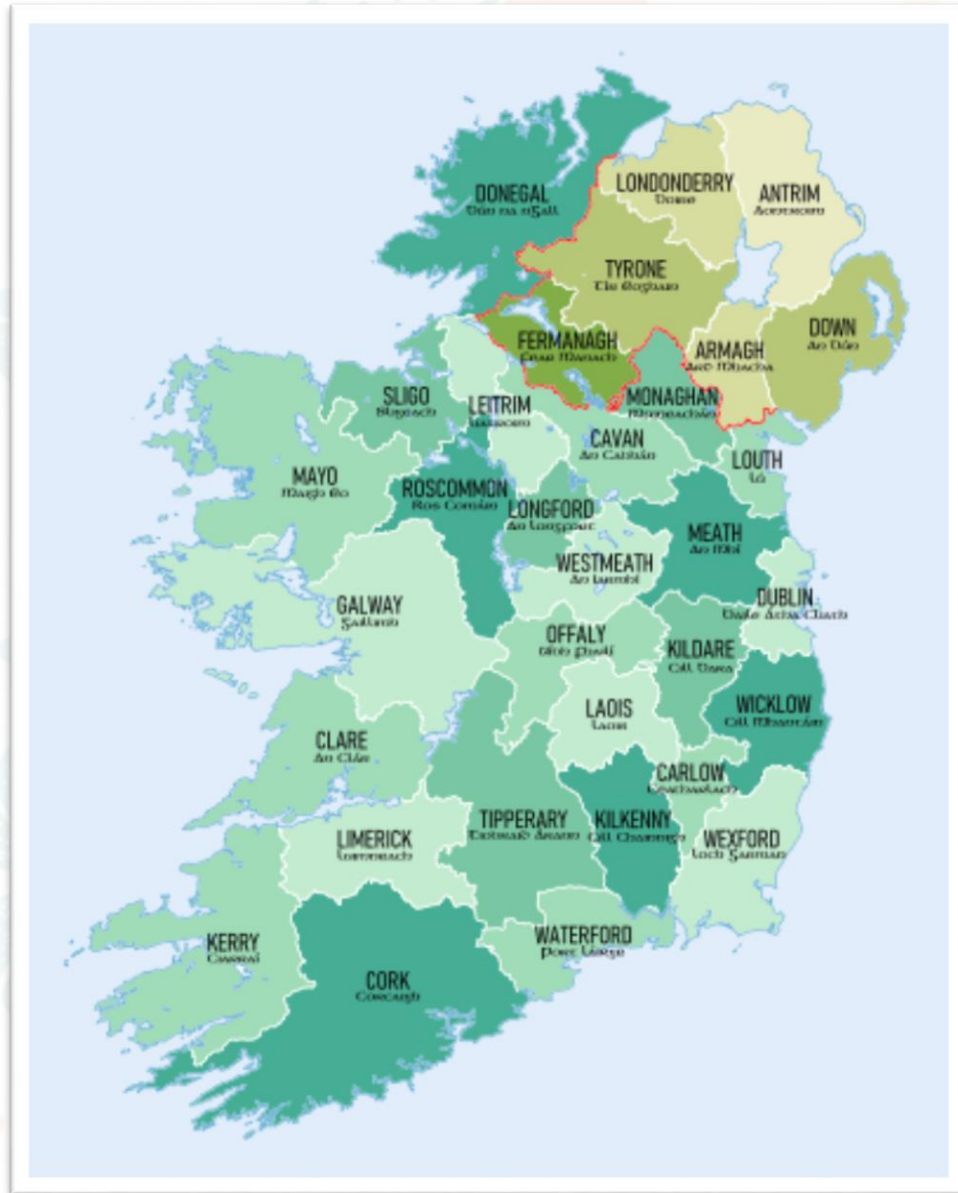


Let's hop back in the car and head to our next stop on our road trip. Does anyone know what county we are visiting next?



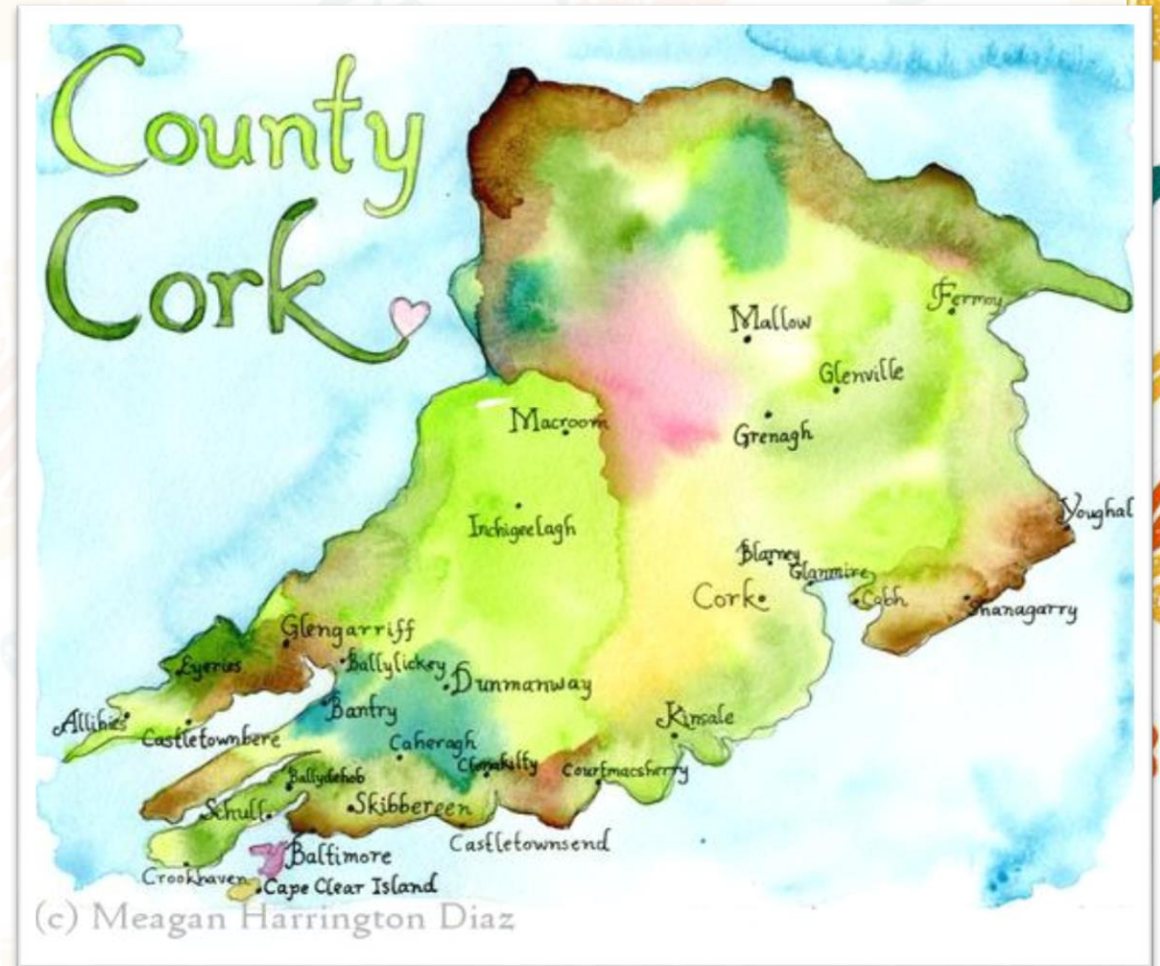

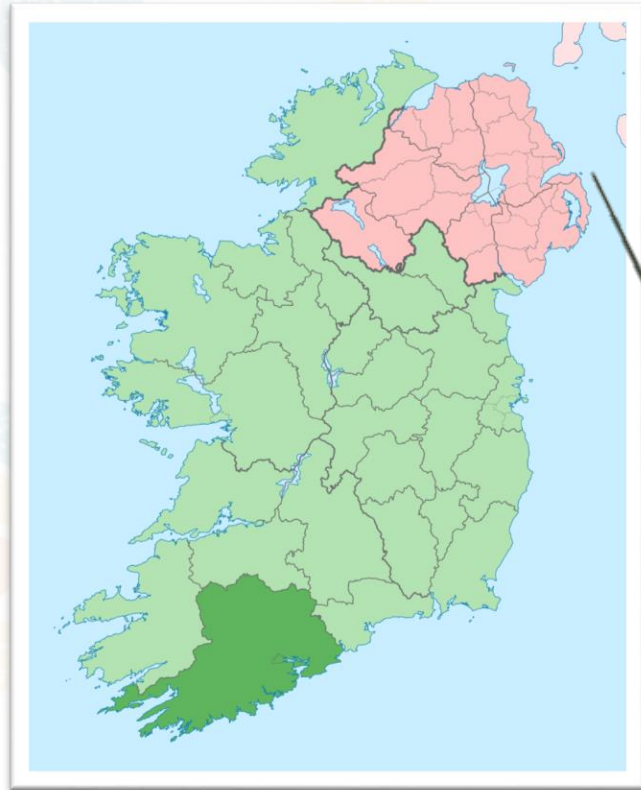

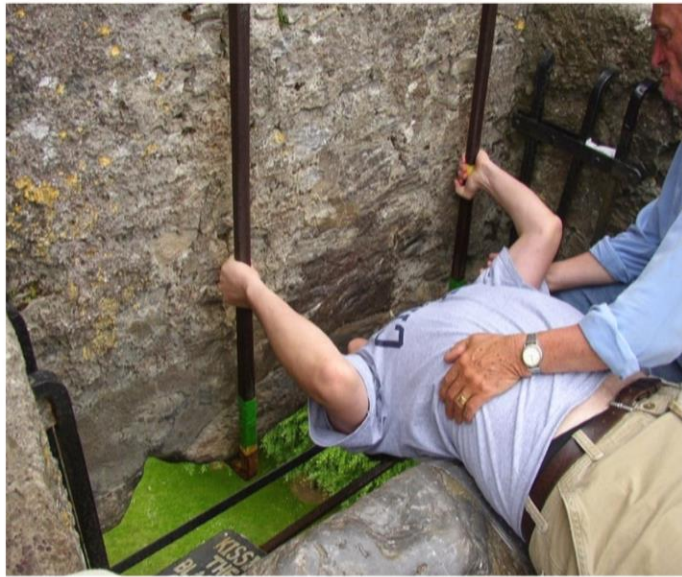
